JRA Distinguished Educator Awardee Paulus Berensohn died June 15. He was a beloved teacher at Penland School of Craft for over 40 years. He was also one of the earliest members of Haystack Mountain School of Crafts in Deer Isle, ME. He is best known for his book, "Finding One's Way with Clay."

Snyderman-Works Galleries

It is with sadness that we report the end of more than 50 years of showing craft art by the Snyderman-Works Galleries. Ruth & Rick have sold their building in Old City, Philadelphia and are migrating to new roles as craft consultants. The JRA has had a long and fruitful relationship with the Snyderman who have hosted JRA study tours on numerous occasions. Many members added to their collections from artists that they represented. Ruth & Rick discovered, showed, and catalogued a full range of craft artists from their first years in South Street and continued when they enlarged their space in Old City. Perhaps, most notably, they created the biennial fiber exhibition which has evolved to include other galleries and venues showing fiber artists. In addition, they served as jurors for the San Angelo Biennial Ceramic Exhibition at the San Angelo Museum of Art in Texas, as well as curating a fiber show at the National Craft Gallery in Kilkenny, Ireland. Ruth has been an active supporter and served on the boards of the Clay Studio in Philadelphia and the Watershed Center for Ceramic Arts in Newcastle, ME. The Snyderman epitomized the essential and joyous roles that gallery owners play in the education of collectors and the success of new, emerging, and established artists. We wish them the best in their new endeavors.
